SC upholds Soren bail: 'HC order well-reasoned'

THE SUPREME Court on Monday dismissed the Enforcement Directorate's plea challenging the bail granted to Jharkhand Chief Minister Hemant Soren in a money laundering case linked to an alleged land scam.

A Bench of Justices B R Gavai and K V Viswanathan said the Jharkhand High Court's judgment on June 28, granting interim bail to Soren, was a "very well-reasoned order" and refused to interfere with it. "We are not inclined to interfere with the impugned order," the Bench said.

ED, said the High Court ought not to have disregarded the statements recorded by it under Section 50 of the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA). "Detailed statements are there which clearly indicate his role," he submitted. But Justice Gavai said the High Court had given "reasons why they were disregarded."

"There is a specific finding that in all records seized from Bhanu Prapat (co-accused), there is nothing implicating applicant (Soren)," the Bench said. As the law officer sought to argue further, Justice Gavai said: "We don't want to observe anything further. If we observe anything further, you will be in difficulty."

14 Naxalites surrender before security forces in Chhattisgarh

AS MANY as 14 Naxalites, one of them carrying a bounty of Rs 1 lakh, surrendered before security forces in Chhattisgarh's Bijapur district on Monday, according to police.

The Naxalites turned themselves in before senior officials from police and the Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF) in Bijapur, citing disappointment with atrocities committed by senior cadres and "inhuman" and "hollow" Maoist ideology. Jitendra Kumar Yadav, Bijapur superintendent of police, said. They were active in the Bhairnagar, Usoon-Pamed, and Gangaor area committees of Maoists, he said.

Among them, woman cadre Nagi Padiyam (38) was active as the head of the Krantikari Adivasi Mahila Sangthan (KAMS) — a fronting wing of Maoists in Marubadka village and carried a reward of Rs 1 lakh.

Padiyam was allegedly involved in murders, firing at police teams and damaging roads, the official said.

The surrendered Naxalites will be provided facilities as per the state government's surrender and rehabilitation policy. With this, 137 Naxalites have quit violence, while 306 have been arrested in the district so far this year, Yadav said.

4.6 lakh pilgrims visit Amarnath shrine this year

THE NUMBER of pilgrims who paid obeisance to Lord Shiva at Amarnath cave shrine in South Kashmir in this year's yatra has crossed 4.65 lakh, surpassing the number of pilgrims who visited the naturally formed ice lingam in 2023.

Officials said that as many as 7,556 pilgrims paid obeisance at the 3,880-metre-high cave shrine on Monday, taking the number of pilgrims this year to 4,66,342 against 4.59 lakh last year. The 52-day pilgrimage will conclude on August 19.
