

MINISTER ASSURES STEPS TO COMBAT CYBER CRIMES

Parameshwara lauds efforts of police dept in maintaining law & order, directs cops to make all districts drug-free

HIGHLIGHTING the rise in cyber crimes, Home Minister G Parameshwara has assured that measures will be taken to deal with them.

Parameshwara noted that India is taking a significant step by forming a special team consisting of DGP, ADGP, IG, and seven SPs to combat cyber crime.

Later, speaking during the inauguration of Hubballi Rural Police Station's new building, Parameshwara expressed confidence in making the twin cities drug-free within two years.

"Some districts have already initiated efforts to become drug-free. Similarly, the police commissioner should take steps to make Hubballi-Dharwad drug-free.

"Over the last two years, there has been no law-and-order breakdown in the state. In the

coastal region, communal clashes were curbed by forming an Anti-Communal Activity Team.

HOME Minister G Parameshwara has said that he will make a request to Chief Minister Siddaramaiah seeking compensation to nine Ayyappa devotees who were seriously injured when a cooking gas (cylinder) exploded at Eshwar temple at Achchavva Nagar Colony, Sainagar, in Hubballi on Monday.

After visiting Karnataka Medical College and Research Institute (KMC&RI) to enquire about the health of the injured, the home minister expressed deep regret over the incident.

"Among the injured, Prakash Baraker has sustained 90% burns. Special care is being provided to him and other injured individuals are also receiving quality treatment as instructed to the medical officials of the institute," he said.

"The Chief Minister is also expected to visit KMC&RI in the coming days to check on the health of the injured. All efforts are being made to provide compensation and an investigation will be conducted into the incident," he added.

For the past few months, the KMC&RI has been functioning under an interim director. Appropriate steps will be taken to appoint a permanent director, the minister said.

Labour and District-In-Charge Minister Santosh Lad highlighted that KMC&RI caters to some of the most critical cases from seven districts of North Karnataka. He praised the institute for functioning as a lifeline for the region and providing excellent treatment.
